## **REVISED COVID GUIDELINES FOR TRIALS**

Agility trials are an important part of the agility community. Exhibitors enjoy the camaraderie, hanging with friends, practicing new skills and earning titles. As we know, due to the Covid-19 virus and the pandemic, we have had to change many things in our daily lives. The same is true for agility. At IncrediPAWS we have been planning, evaluating, and researching ways to safely hold agility trials. We will be complying with the Ohio Governor's guidelines for opening up the state and for mass meetings. If trials cannot be held, we will notify all competitors by email before the closing and all checks received will be shredded.

We are hopeful we will be able to hold agility trials. We want exhibitors, workers and judges to be in a safe environment. As a result, we will be changing our trial format and we will be imposing new guidelines and restrictions.

For agility trials offered by IncrediPAWS, the following guidelines will be in effect.

1. The entry limit will be a maximum of 40 handlers.
2. There will be limited worker crating in the building. All other dogs must be crated from the car. Exhibitors will have the opportunity to sign up for crating spots. When not working or running, exhibitors will need to remain outside.
3. Walk thrus will be limited to 25 handlers. Depending on the number of handlers in each height, handlers may be allowed to remain in the building while their height is running. This will be determined once entries close.
4. Anyone entering the building will need to wear a mask which will include all workers and ring crew. Exhibitors do not have to wear a mask when they run, but will be required to put their mask on before and after their run.
5. Exhibitors will maintain six-foot social distancing inside and outside the building. Please be respectful of your fellow exhibitors.
6. There will be no seating/viewing area and no chairs will be allowed in the building.
7. A gate steward will be at the door directing you as to when to enter the building for walk-thrus and running your dog.
8. In order to maintain social distancing, a limited number of exhibitors will be allowed in the building at one time. The number will vary up to 25 exhibitors depending on the class and run order.

9. Handlers may place their leash in their pocket or wear them while running the course. If handlers elect to drop their leash as the start, a leash runner will use a paper towel to pick up and transport the leash.
10. A monitor will be available near the exit to see the results of your run. Results will be posted outside the building. In addition, results will be emailed to the exhibitors following the trial weekend.
11. Course maps will be posted outside the building. There will not be any paper course maps so plan on taking a picture of the maps.
12. There will not be food or beverages at the trial. Competitors will need to bring their own food and drinks.
13. Please do not bring MACH cakes or desserts to share with exhibitors.
14. Ribbons will not be self-serve. A worker will place stickers on them and bring them to a table on the front porch for pickup.
15. There will be plenty of soap and paper towels. Please wash your hands frequently.
16. We are hoping to be able to stream the runs through Facebook Live so everyone can watch the runs from their phone or tablet outside the building. We will have a better idea if this is going to happen as we approach the closing date.

Covid-19 continues to change our daily lives. If you are entering this trial, be sure you are comfortable with our new guidelines and are willing to comply with social distancing and wearing a mask. Exhibitors not complying with these guidelines will be excused from the trial.
